Setting Up Pocket Manager for HP Ipaq HX2100 and Nokia 6234

This topic covers specific setup instructions for the HP Ipaq HX2100 device to enable it to connect to Pocket RAMM using the Nokia 6234 mobile phone as a bluetooth modem, via Vodafone GPRS connection.

► Setting Up Pocket Manager for HP Ipaq HX2100 and Nokia 6234

- 1 Enable bluetooth services on the Nokia. Select **Settings > Connectivity > Bluetooth**. Set *Bluetooth* to **On**, and *My Phones Visibility* to **Permanently Visible**.
- 2 Set up a dialup connection on the Ipaq. Tap **Start > Settings > Connections**.

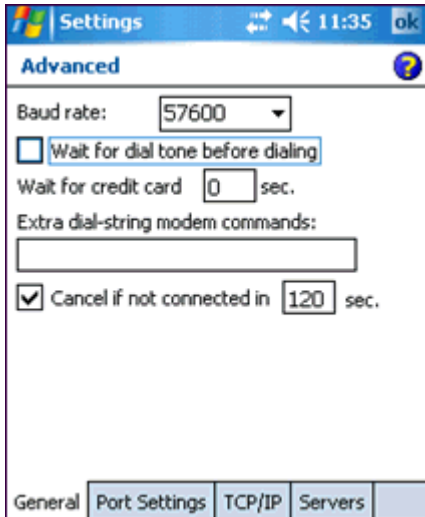


- 3 Tap **Add a new modem connection** in the Connections window.



- 4 Enter **Vodafone** as the name for the connection, select **Bluetooth Dialup Modem** and tap **Next**.
- 5 Enter ***99#** as the number to dial, and tap **Next**.
- 6 You will now see the Vodafone Settings screen. Leave *User name*, *Password* and *Domain* blank. Tap **Advanced**.

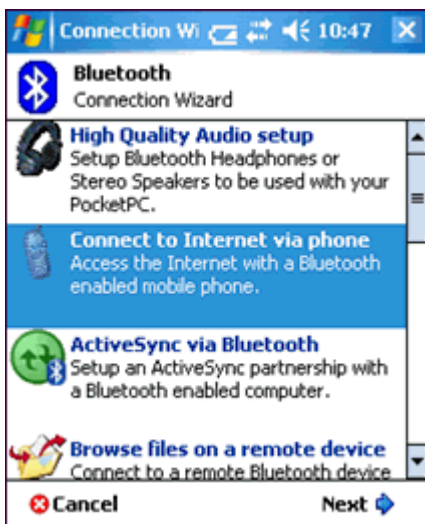
- 7 In the Advanced screen, set the *Baud Rate* to **57600** and untick **Wait for dial tone before dialing**.



- 8 Tap **OK**, and when you return to the Vodafone Settings screen tap **Finish**. You will return to the global Settings screen. You've finished setting up the modem connection.
- 9 Now tap the **Bluetooth** icon in the same screen to set up the bluetooth connection to the Nokia phone.



- 10 In the Bluetooth General screen, tap the **Bluetooth Manager** link at the bottom.
- 11 In the Bluetooth My Shortcuts screen, tap **New**.
- 12 Tap **Connect to the Internet via Phone**, and then tap **Next**.



- 13 In the *Prepare your phone - Step 1 - Phone Selection* screen of the connection wizard, tap **Next**.
- 14 In the *Prepare your phone - Step 2 - Preparing Bluetooth* screen of the connection wizard, tap **Next**.
- 15 If you have set up your phone correctly for bluetooth as in step 1 above, the connection wizard should now find the Nokia phone.

Tap the **Nokia 6234** icon to *pair* the Ipaq with the Nokia.

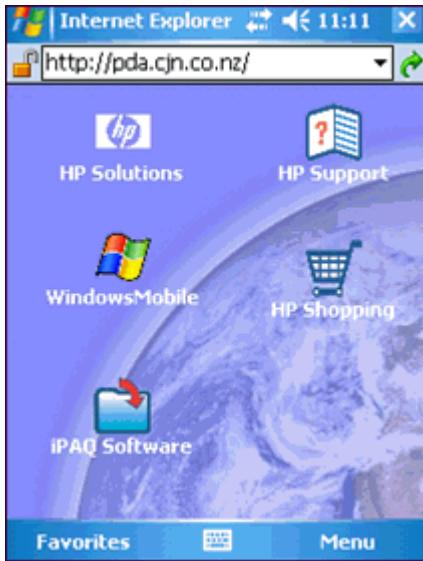


- 16 Enter the *passkey* as **1234** on the PDA, and tap **Next**.
- 17 The Nokia will now show the message *Pair with wm_pda_name*. Enter the same passkey code **1234** on the Nokia phone and press the **centre button**. When you see the message *Allow this device to connect automatically?* press the **centre button** again.
- 18 On the Ipaq, a small Bluetooth dialog box will now show *Device pairing - Authenticating device 'Nokia 6234'*.
- 19 Tick **Use this phone as default connection to the internet**. Make sure the **Vodafone** connection you set up in step 4 above is selected, and tap **Next**.



- 20 Tap **Finish** when the wizard tells you that the shortcut has been created.
- 21 Tap **OK** and then **OK** again to return to the Today screen.

- 22 The final step is to download and install Pocket Manager from the CJN Technologies PDA software download page. Launch Internet Explorer: tap **Start > Internet Explorer**.



Enter the address **pda.cjn.co.nz** (the http:// will be automatically inserted) and tap the green arrow to connect to the Internet and go to that page.

- 23 You will see a *Network Log On* dialog. Tick **Save Password**, leave the other fields blank, and tap **OK**. You will not see this dialog again.
- 24 You'll be taken to the PDA software download page (below). Click the **pmsetup.cab** link to download and install Pocket Manager.
